Rosedene Guest House was established over 25 years ago by a Yacht Captain, Nick, during a stop in Cape Town on a world cruise. His goal was to create a Guest House with an informal welcoming Home from Home feel, with friendly and informative staff to help visitors make the best of their stay in Cape Town and its surrounds. Rosedene Guest House had its origins as part of a rose farm on the slopes below Table Mountain dating back to the 1800s. The house has over the years had a number of conversions and additions, the latest of which has converted the property into an 11-room Guest House.

The courtyard and garden setting creates a tranquil ‘village like’ feel to the Guest House even though it is located in the centre of the city. The covered verandas (stoeps), decks, and courtyard have magnificent views of Table Mountain, Lions Head, Signal Hill, the City, and Table Bay. The Guest House is also situated on trendy Kloof Street, and close to Long Street and Bree Street. These have a huge range of restaurants, bars and shops, making it ideal for those who wish to stay in the city for business or pleasure.

The V&A Waterfront is only ten minutes away and there is easy access to the rest of the Peninsula, the Wine lands and start of the Garden Route.

### **Area Overview**

At 19,500 km<sup>2</sup> (7,500 mi<sup>2</sup>), the world-renowned Kruger National Park is the largest national park in South Africa, and also the oldest in all of Africa. Given its size, numerous airports, and excellent access road, Kruger and its surrounding private game reserves are an attractive option for many travelers.

Kruger is best known for its high wildlife density, including the Big Five (lion, leopard, rhino, elephant, and buffalo). Hundreds of other mammals and unique bird species also make their home in Kruger. Mountains, plains, and tropical forests are all part of the landscape, ensuring both scenic and exciting game drives.

### **Check in at Shindzela Tented Camp**

### **Property Overview**

Shindzela, named after the honey badger in the Shangaan language, is an unfenced tented camp in the Timbavati Private Game Reserve, part of the Greater Kruger National Park in South Africa.

Shindzela has an open plan living, dining and bar area overlooking a dry river bed and watering hole. There is a small swimming pool and an open-air boma where dinner is served.

## **Experience & Activities**

Shindzela offers two game drives per day in open 4 x 4 vehicles – one early morning and one late afternoon or early evening. The park has the Big 5 and guides will endeavour to track them, as well as taking opportunities to point out the insects, plants, and some of the 350 birds in the area.

You can choose to substitute one game drive with a morning walking safari that usually lasts up to two and a half hours. During summer months the walking safaris may be of shorter duration due to the thicker vegetation and summer heat.

## **Accommodations**

Each of the eight safari tents have a grass thatched roof, with canvas sides and lots of windows. They can be made up as twin or double beds. The ensuite bathroom with shower is semi open to the elements has a shower. Each tent has a wooden deck and chairs so that guests can sit and enjoy the view of the bush and any passing animals.

## **Property Overview**

Inyati Game Lodge is situated in the western sector of the Sabi Sand Wildtuin, which is a private game reserve sharing a common unfenced boundary with the Kruger National Park. It spans 50,000 hectares and is renowned for providing some of the best game viewing in Africa.

The reserve is not open to the general public. Each private lodge has exclusive traversing rights over their area. Inyati's rangers drive specially designed safari vehicles which are allowed off-road, ensuring guests get exclusive and intimate game viewing opportunities.

The reserve has a dense concentration of wildlife and is home to the Big 5 – elephant, lion, rhino, leopard and buffalo. Cheetah, giraffe, zebra, wild dogs and a vast variety of antelope and other species may also be closely observed, free roaming within their own territories. Inyati is one of the best places in the world to get up close and personal with the elusive leopard.

## **Experience & Activities**

At Inyati the days are designed to thrill guests with intimate wildlife encounters and the nights to delight with the indulgence and romance of the African night. Inyati offers a range of activities from game drives and guided bush walks, to star gazing, fishing, workouts at the fully-equipped gym, swimming, young rangers' programmes and community tours.

Inyati has been recognised by the Lilizela Tourism Awards for the best "Visitor's Experience Award for the Best Wildlife Encounters". Open game vehicles, which seat up to 10 guests, are driven by experienced rangers



and insightful trackers. With over 9,000 hectares of traversing wilderness, no two game drives are ever the same.

## Property Overview

MalaMala Camp is a haven of understated luxury combining warm comfort and superb service with unrivalled views of the Sand River and surrounding bushveld. It is truly a place of legends where rare photographs, old maps, and extraordinary mementos rub shoulders with the works of renowned contemporary wildlife artists. The camp is an unfenced oasis in the middle of the bush.

Every aspect of Mala Mala Camp is designed to appreciate and enjoy the view of the surrounding wilds. Pathways wind their way along the perimeter of the camp to reveal individual ochre colored units tucked into the greenery which flanks the Sand River. Massive trees and rolling green lawns are filled with birdsong, with the occasional antelope or elephant seeking the succulence of greenery.

## Experience & Activities

Activities include Big 5 viewing, bird watching, game drives, walking safaris, and wildlife tours. The capacity on game drives is limited to six guests per safari vehicle.

## Accommodations

### Luxury Room

Smaller than the suites, the luxury rooms enjoy the same panoramic view across the bushveld and the wilderness beyond. Large sliding doors and an intimate private deck offer the opportunity to appreciate one's surrounding between game drives. Each room has an en-suite bathroom with double vanities, a shower only, and separate WC. Facilities include 24-hour temperature control, a large cupboard, direct-dial telephone, a mini bar, tea station, and in room safe. Each room has twin 3'6" beds which can be made up to a king size double bed on request.

We can recommend Malanil or Malarone as well as Mozitec. Consult your doctor for more information and check for any contra-indications with medicine you already take as well as possible side effects you need to be aware of.

## **Cover up, buttercup and spray, spray, spray**

When the sun starts to sink, put on long pants and long sleeves to minimise possible bites and spray the hell out of your legs and arms (even covered) with a good bug spray or smear with a bug stick. Don't forget your ears! And cheeks! And ankles.

Mozzies love ankles.

## **Doom your room**

Use bug spray to knock down insects in your room or tent at night, before you go to dinner. Give it a good all-over spray, shut the doors/flaps and walk away. Here in Sarf Efrica we have a spray called Doom. Others are called Target, Peaceful Sleep and Morein.

For the majority of accommodations, your room is prepared for you by the wonderful house keepers so no need to worry about the above.

## **Use your mozzie net**

That gorgeous, diaphanous netting around your bed is not a romantic come-on, it's designed to keep winged, bitey things at bay. So use it. Along with all of the above.
